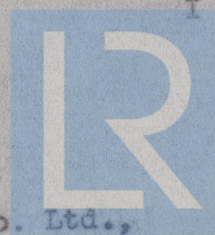

I was duly favoured with your letter of the 23rd instant, forwarding plans, in triplicate, of "RB" type superheaters proposed in connection with Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co's Engines No. 666, Yard No. 666, and with regard thereto I have the pleasure to acquaint you that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the steel castings be made at approved works and tested as required by the Rules, a safety valve be fitted to each part of the superheaters which can be isolated from the boilers, the superheaters be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and the whole be tested to three times the working pressure.

One set of the plans now approved is returned herewith together with the usual survey request form, which I shall be obliged if you will kindly complete and return to this Office in due course.
