Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 22nd ultimo, respecting the steamer "ARLY", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them a report of a general examination which has recently been held on the vessel by the Society's Newport Surveyors. The Surveyors state that the cross bunker requires to be scaled and coated.

In view, however, of the satisfactory result of the examination, the Committee have decided to assign a notation of "Examined 1,20", and to accede to the Owners' request for the postponement of the completion of the Special Survey No.3 until June next.

The Surveyors also state that the donkey boiler should not be used again until it has been repaired, and I may add that the vessel remains as classed on this condition.
