Dear Sirs,

E. I duly received your letter of the 3rd instant forwarding a plan, in duplicate, showing the general arrangement of Main Switchboard proposed for Messrs. Chantiers de Normandie's Motor Trawler "T8", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the arrangement showing fuses mounted on the back of the switchboard does not comply with Section 3, Clause 2(e), but will be accepted provided the space between the switchboard and bulkhead be kept clear of obstruction so that the fuses are easily accessible. The minimum width of gangway behind the switchboard is to be not less than 600 mm.

In other respects, the plan forwarded by you will be approved, provided the installation be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electrical Equipment be complied with.

One copy of the plan is returned herewith.
