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The name of this works was deleted/<sup>last year</sup>from the List of Steel Manufacturers recognised by the Committee on account of non-compliance with the requirements of Circular No. 1618 relating to Annual Inspection.

The Paris Office now states that the Firm <sup>has received</sup> have received an order for Rivet Bars intended for a vessel building to class in France, and the Firm have, accordingly, applied for this works to be re-instated in the List.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Paris Office be asked to inform the Metz Surveyor that he should make a complete examination of the plant and methods of manufacture at this works, and should carry out a series of tests on material produced, in a similar manner to that adopted for new steel works.

The material for the rivet bars mentioned above may be utilised for the purpose of forming part of the series of tests required; but the Surveyor should not sign any documents concerning this material until his report on the whole works has been examined in this Office.

The Surveyor should charge a fee of £15 for placing the name of the Firm on the List of Steel Manufacturers recognised by the Committee, and in addition, plus expenses a fee at the rate of £5 per day/for his services in carrying out the inspection and tests.

It should be added that the above fees are not intended to include the ordinary charges for routine testing of steel material.
