I duly received your letter of the 14th instant, respecting the Motor Trawler "T8" building by Messrs. Chantiers et Ateliers de St. Nazaire, and I note that the arrangements on board this vessel are such that access may at all times be obtained to the slush wells in the fish holds and to the bilge strum in the forward store.

In these circumstances, the proposal to dispense with the sounding pipes to these compartments may be accepted.

It is concluded the fore peak is not intended for water ballast, and the proposal to lead the air pipe from this compartment to the space underneath the forecastle deck, and not to the open, may therefore be accepted.
