I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 12th instant, of sea inlet chests for Messrs. Chantiers de Normandie's Yard No. T-8, and with regard thereto I have to state that the arrangements as shewn will be approved, provided the steel castings be made at an approved works and under the usual conditions of survey and testing, the electrodes be of an approved type, and the chests be fitted to your satisfaction.

It is concluded that the pressure of supply of the steam or compressed air for clearing purposes will not exceed 8 kgs/cm<sup>2</sup>, but I shall be glad if you will be so good as to confirm this.

The duplicate copy of the plan is being retained for reference.
