E. I duly received your letter of the 4th instant respecting the trawler "T.8" building at the Grand Quevilly Shipyard of Chantiers de Normandie to this Society's class.

It is noted that an order for plates for starting air receivers intended for this vessel has been placed with Messrs. Societe Anonyme des Hauts-Fourneaux, Forges et Acieries de Denain & d'Anzin, Denain, and in the circumstances it is considered desirable that the inspection of material ordered in the North of France and intended for the trawler "T.8" should be undertaken by the Society's Surveyor at Dunkirk, as was done in the case of the motor schooner "Oiseau des Iles".

I am therefore advising the Society's Surveyors at Dunkirk and Antwerp accordingly.
