E. I have to acquaint you that an order for plates for starting air receivers intended for the Trawler "T.8" under construction by Chantiers de Normandie at the Grand Quevilly Shipyard, near Rouen, to this Society's class, has been placed with Soc. Anonyme des Hauts-Fourneaux, Forges et Acieries de Denain & d'Anzin, Denain.

In this connexion I think it well to draw your attention to my letter of the 15th January 1935 respecting material intended for the motor schooner constructed by Soc.
