Dear Sir,

E. I have to acquaint you that it is understood from the Society's Paris Office that an order for plates for starting air receivers intended for the trawler "T.8" under construction by Chantiers de Normandie at the Grand Quevilly Shipyard, near Rouen, to this Society's class, has been placed with Soc. Anon. des Hauts-Fourneaux, Forges et Acieries de Denain & d'Anzin, Denain.

In this connexion I think it well to draw your attention to my letter of the 15th January, 1935, respecting material intended for the motor schooner constructed by Soc. Anon. des Anciens Chantiers Dubigeon, and to acquaint you that, as in that case, it is considered desirable that the inspection of material ordered in the North of France and intended for the trawler "T.8" should be undertaken by you and not by the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp as is normally the case.

In the circumstances, therefore, I shall be glad if you will give this matter the requisite attention.

I may add that I have informed the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp of the action taken in this matter.
