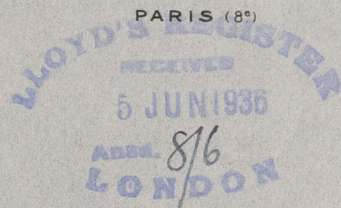

I beg to inform you that an order for plates for starting air receivers, intended for the trawler "T.8", building at the Grand Quevilly Shipyards (Rouen district), to the Society's class, has been placed with Messrs Société Anonyme des Hauts-Fourneaux, Forges et Aciéries de Denain & d'Anzin, Denain (Nord) France,

It is observed that these Works are in the district of the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp; but, I should be much obliged if you would kindly inform me whether, as in the case of the "OISEAU DES ILES", which was built last year, in France, the materials ordered in the North of France for the "T.8" may be tested by the Dunkirk Surveyor.
