In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether you have any such order in hand and if so furnish me with all the necessary particulars (Copy of order, state of advancement etc.) in order to enable me to carry out the necessary tests in due course.

In particular, it is reported that the Soc. Anon. des Hauts Fourneaux, Forges et Aciéries de Denain ~~and~~ et d'Anzin, at Denain, has received an order for plates for starting air receivers intended for this trawler.
