

Motor Trawler to be built by Chantiers de Normandie, Grand-Quevilly, for Mr. Huret, of Bordeaux.

The hull of this vessel will be surveyed during construction by Mr. MacGeachie, the Society's Non-Exclusive Surveyor at Rouen. The engines are to be constructed at St. Nazaire, at which port the duties are undertaken by the Havre Surveyors.

A letter has been received from the Havre Surveyors stating they presume that it is intended that they shall carry out the survey during construction of the whole of the propelling machinery and auxiliaries, and subsequently the installation on board at Rouen. At the same time they desire to know if it is intended that they should join Mr. MacGeachie in the survey of the hull.

It is submitted the Havre Surveyors be informed that they should undertake the survey of the whole of the propelling machinery and auxiliaries at St. Nazaire, and should arrange to pay a few visits, at suitable intervals, during the construction of the hull and installation of the machinery at Rouen.
