I was duly favoured with your letter of the 13th instant, forwarding a plan, in triplicate, showing details of shafting proposed for the engine being built by your goodselves for a Trawler intended for Mr. Huret, of Bordeaux, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that, with 4 SCSA oil engines for main propelling purposes, having 7 cylinders, diameter of cylinders 450 mm., stroke 850 mm., revolutions per minute 165-170, maximum pressure in cylinders 46 Kgs. per square cm., B.H.P. 1030, diameter of propeller 3000 mm. and screw shaft with continuous liner, the following sizes of shafting will be approved, viz:-

Thrust	300 mm. dia. in way of collars and reduced to 282 mm. dia.
Intermediate ...	242 mm. dia.
Screw	267 mm. dia.

The plan showing details of shafting will also be approved, and one copy is returned herewith.
