

TRANSLATION.

11th March, 1936.

Dear Sirs,

We are building for our Normandie Yard, as you are probably aware, the motor for a 68 metres Trawler, for Mr. Huret de Bordeaux, which is to be classed with your Society.

The main propulsion will be a motor of the Burmeister & Wain type, 4 stroke, single acting, 7 cylinders of 450 mm. diameter and 850 mm. stroke. The power developed will be 1250 I.H.P. at 165-170 R.P.M.

We beg to send you herewith 3 copies of the plan of crank shaft which is of the "built up" type.

The characteristics of the materials employed are indicated on the plan. They are notably superior to those required by your Rules.

We shall be glad if you will kindly approve this plan and let us have it by return of post if possible.
