This vessel was built in 1919 under British Corporation Survey, and is now under survey at Calcutta by Mr. Leathard with a view to classification with this Society.

A telegram has been received from Mr. Leathard stating that the panting arrangements are not in accordance with the plans jointly approved by this Society and the B.C. for these Standard Ships, ~~the~~ ^{apparently} in many previous cases, the B.C. have permitted departures from the mutually agreed arrangements.

It will be observed that the vessel has been in service for 7 years, and Mr. Leathard reports that the panting arrangements are efficient.

It is submitted that provided the Surveyor be thoroughly satisfied as to their efficiency as existing in the ship, the panting arrangements could be approved.
