This vessel was built by the Sunderland Shipbuilding Co., Ltd, in 1919 to the British Corporation class and is of the Standard B. Type.

Plans for this type of vessel were jointly approved by the Representatives of this Society and the British Corporation at the Ministry of Shipping during the War.

With a view to classification with this Society the Calcutta Surveyor, who was joined by Mr. Leathard of London, now forwards a report giving particulars of scantlings and further reports the vessel placed in dry dock and the requirements of the Rules for ships not built under survey carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100 A.1 with record of survey 10-26 and notation of s.s. Cal. No. 3-10-26.
