## FRIGATE AND TRAWLER SUNK

An official Admiralty communique issued yesterday stated: "The Board of Admiralty regret to announce that the frigate H.M.S. *Capel* (Lieutenant B. G. Heslop, D.S.C., R.N.) and the trawler H.M.S. *Heybourne Wyke* (Skipper Lieutenant F. Wilson, R.N.R.) have been lost in Allied operations for the liberation of Europe. The next of kin of casualties have been informed."
