GENERAL EXAMINATION partly held.

To complete the GENERAL EXAMINATION some started and
slack rivets in way of frames to floors and brackets to stiffeners
in fore peak tank require to be renewed.

It is stated that this will be completed at Greenhithe
before the end of September.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is worthy to remain as
classed and to have a notation of "Examined 9,43" valid for 12
months as recommended when the defective rivets in the fore peak
tank have been dealt with.
