The Cradley Boiler Co. Ltd., attend their works at Cradley Heath on the 24th April, 1934 and subsequently for the purpose of inspecting and witnessing the hydraulic test on three mild steel rivetted air receivers, Nos. 20623/4/5 made to the order of The Newbury Diesel Co. Ltd., No. 8014/2265 and intended for Messrs. George Brown & Co. for M.V. "GRIT"

The plates from which the receivers were made were identified from the signed mill sheets, the receivers were examined during construction, the workmanship throughout being satisfactory. When completed, they were tested by hydraulic pressure to 600 lb. per square inch, examined under this pressure and were, as far as could be seen, satisfactory, showing no signs of leakage.
