With reference to your letter of 28th December, 1944, received on 13/2/44. Regret to have to inform you that the ship in question was lost at sea in December, 1944.

An Enquiry was held at Malta, which Lloyds Hull Surveyor and Machinery Surveyor attended. Certain questions as to examination carried out in July were asked, and the Enquiry Board was referred to Report of general examination carried out. A copy of your letter of 27th September, 1944, was passed to the Board of Enquiry.

Findings of the Court are not known.
