In regard to the riveting of the boundry angles, it is noted that the spacing has been changed from 4 diameters to 5 diameters, and the Shipbuilders request advice as to whether this figure is to be regarded as a maximum, as with single riveting they are anxious about effective caulking over such a length.

The recommendations and other amendments have been carefully noted and will be carried out.
