I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th. instant respecting the proposed bunker bulkheads in the steamer "KUMANOVO", and enclosing the amended plans for them.

In regard to the riveting of the boundry angles, it is noted that the spacing has been changed from 4 diameters to 5 diameters, and the Shipbuilders request advice as to whether this figure is to be regarded as a maximum, as with single riveting they are anxious about effective caulking over such a length.
