the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners, attend on board the Steel Twin Screw Steamer "EDMANOVO" 1409 Gross Tons of Dubrovnik, whilst the vessel was in the floating dock at the Brodogradiliste "Split" on the 23rd. October, 1935, and subsequently, for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage to the vessel's machinery alleged sustained through the vessel striking the quay wall at Herceg Novi with her starboard side during a gale on the 19th. Sept. 1935. For further particulars, see Log Books.

FOUND

RECOMMENDED

Starboard propeller blades badly distorted and torn and one broken.

Propeller to be renewed.

Starboard thrust shoes found scored with indications of overheating.

Shoes to be re-metalled.

L.P. ahead and astern guide plates found cracked and scored on faces.

Guide plates to be renewed.

L.P. and M.P. ahead guide slippers cracked through faces.

Slippers to be renewed.

L.P. bottom end bearing scored with indications of overheating.

Bottom end bearing halves to be re-metalled.

Steering engine starboard lead pulley broken. Replacement fitted after accident examined and found efficient for permanent service.

Further recommended: that all removals for access be restored in good condition: that all renewed, repaired and disturbed parts be coated as original.

The above recommendations are made in order to place the machinery of the vessel in as good condition as it was in before having sustained the damage in question.
