

Surveyed the Twin screw steamer "KUMANOVO", 1410 tons gross,  
of Dubrovnik, afloat and in dry dock, for special survey No.3  
and repairs with a view to classification in this Society,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's  
Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs  
recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and  
that I have Recommended that she be eligible to be  
classed 100 A 1 "Shade deck", "With freeboard", with record of  
survey 2,25 and notation of s.s.No.3-Fiu-2,25, when the survey  
is complete and subject to two bower anchors being tested,  
being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes. -
