I am in receipt of your letter of 28th instant enclosing midship section, profile and deck plans of this vessel, also a copy of your letter of 28th inst. addressed to Messrs Baburizza & Co. Ltd., the Owners' Representatives in London. Your remarks are noted and will have attention in due course.

It is observed that a number of amendments are indicated in red ink on the approved plans, and it is concluded that those referring to modifications to riveting, increased thickness of shell and bulkhead plating, scantlings of side keelsons &c.&c. are the original scantlings as built and have not been amended by you, seeing that the vessel is receiving a class with freeboard.

I shall be glad however if you will kindly confirm this.


