Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 15th instant regarding the steel twin screw passenger steamer "KUMANOVO" ex "GRAND DUKE ALEXANDER MICHAILOVITCH", I have pleasure in stating that the scantlings and arrangements as indicated on the plans forwarded by you have been examined, and that provided the requirements of the Society's Rules for ships not built under survey be complied with, and on completion of the survey a satisfactory report be received from the Society's Surveyors the steamer will be eligible to be classed LOOA1, with a freeboard to be assigned.

The plans in question are being forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Trieste who are being requested to furnish the necessary information for freeboard assignment, together with particulars regarding the position of the sidelights and the extent of the collision bulkhead.
