I am in receipt of your report No.673, and copy of report dated 19th April issued to the Owners regarding the steamer "GRAND DUKE ALEXANDER MICHAÏLOVITCH", and note that this survey was undertaken by you in consequence of a communication received from Mr. Turnbull, the Principal Surveyor for Italy.

The contents of your report are noted, but with regard to the document issued to the Owners dated 19th April, I think it well to point out that as the survey carried out was a condition survey held on a vessel not classed in the Society's Register Book, it should have been done in your private capacity as a Marine Surveyor, and the form of report issued to the Owners should have been on private paper and without the Society's heading.

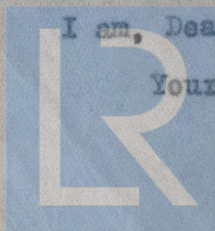
Perhaps you will be glad enough to note this for future guidance.
