S.S. "KINGSWOOD". - ENGINE NO.270.

In connection with the installation of an exhaust geared turbine in the above vessel, we have prepared a plan showing the modifications to the thrust recess to accomodate the machinery, which is carried on a cast iron baseplate to be secured direct on to the tank top plates.

The alterations to the existing structure comprise.-

1. Removal of existing thrust seating.
2. " " " thrust recess side and top plates.
3. Cutting away of engine room aft bulkhead.
4. Fitting doubling plate to tank top plate.
5. Cutting holes in tank top plates for oil drain tanks.
6. Fitting of new welded steel oil drain tanks in ballast tanks.

To illustrate the above we enclose, for your consideration, comments and approval if found satisfactory, duplicate copy of print No.E.270/30 showing the modifications required. To assist you, we also enclose duplicate copies of plans showing ship structure as originally constructed, Prints No.E.270/31-2-3-4-5.
