Dear Sirs,

I duly received Mr. Akester's letter of the 18th instant enclosing plans of cast steel quadrant, tiller and hand gear for new steering gear for the S.S. "KINGSWOOD", and with regard thereto I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements of the main tiller and quadrant as shewn will be approved.

With regard to the plan of quadrant and pinion for the overhead hand gear, I have to point out that the Rule diameter of the rudder head is 10 inches, and the case is therefore similar to that of Messrs. Short Brothers' Yard No. 453, in regard to which instructions were sent in my letter of the 19th instant. You should therefore discuss this case also with the Makers.

I may add that according to the records in this Office blocks and tackle were originally provided as the second means of steering.

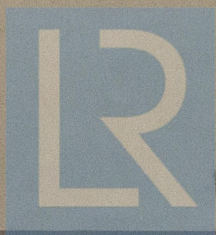
