Dear Sirs,

With reference to the case of your steamer "KINGSWOOD", I beg to acquaint you that in compliance with your telephonic request this morning I have to-day cabled to Mr. McCowan, at Sydney, to the effect that you have decided to tow the vessel to the Tyne, without cargo, for permanent repairs, and that you desire the temporary repairs for this voyage to be kept down to a minimum. Mr. McCowan has also been informed of the conditions under which the Committee are agreeable to the vessel being towed home, as set out in my letter to you of the 10th instant.

I take this opportunity to forward herewith an account for £8.2.3, the cost of the five cablegrams which have been despatched to Australia from this office since the 4th ultimo.
