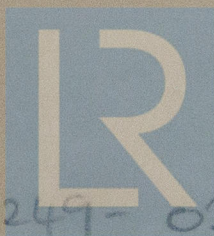
I may add that this cablegram was despatched from Adelaide, so that it appears unlikely that Mr. McCowan will reach Sydney before Friday.
