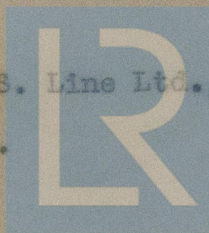
You will observe also that a cabled report has been asked for, and its details will be at once transmitted to you on receipt.
