Captain Gross of Messrs. McCowen & Gross Ltd., telephoned to say that the above vessel has sustained heavy weather damage off Gibraltar, and that both hawse pipes have been broken.

She is proceeding to Ancona and Venice with a coal cargo which will be discharged at both ports, and she is expected to arrive at Ancona on the 18th/20th instant.

Captain Gross desires the Society's Surveyors to be authorised to inspect the damage with a view to recommending such temporary repairs as may be necessary to enable the vessel to proceed on her voyage, and he further requests that details of the damage should be cabled to this Office.
