I duly received your letter of the 24th instant, with enclosures advised therein respecting Messrs. Burntisland S.B. Co's Yard No. 213, and I have to inform you that the amended plan of arrangement of suction to No. 6 double bottom tank will be approved, provided that arrangements be as shown on the plan and the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1936-7) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

Two copies of the above plan are returned herewith, together with the plans forwarded for reference purposes.


The sketch of change-over connection for the oil fuel and water ballast systems will also be approved and is returned herewith.

With reference to the remarks contained in the last paragraph of your letter, I have to point out that since No. 6 tank is not situated in a boiler room, no exception need be taken to the omission of cement in this compartment.
