The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

Nature of Survey

The 1st S.S. No.1, due 8,33, has been partly held.

The Antwerp Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, the Special Survey advanced and bottom cleaned and coated.

Damage through striking quay and collision repaired as follows:- 1 shell plate renewed, 3 shell plates and 1 frame faired.

A cofferdam has been constructed between Nos. 1 & 2 oil fuel deep tanks for the purpose of carrying palm oil in No.1 tank and alterations effected to the double bottom in way and the piping arrangements in accordance with approved plans.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4,33, and the notation "Carrying Palm Oil in Deep Tank forward"
