Dear Sirs,

M. I duly received your letter of the 13th instant enclosing one from the Mercantile Marine Engineering & Graving Docks Co., regarding proposed alterations to the steamer "LEOPOLDVILLE", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the reduced scantlings proposed for the channel frames can only be approved provided the height of the frame brackets be increased 300 mm., or alternatively, reversed bars 90 x 90 x 10 be fitted to every third frame, Reversed bars to take three rivets in frame and beam brackets.

I have therefore wired you as per copy of translation enclosed herewith.
