Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Herbert's letter of the 13th instant, forwarding a draft for Fcs. 132,180 payable on the 15th December next, in respect of the survey and classification fees due in the case of the s.s.

"LEOPOLDVILLE"; and I take it that we are right in concluding that this draft, if presented for immediate payment, will be subject to discount.

It is not quite understood why Messrs. Cockerill desire to pay the fees which are now due by a bill at three months sight, and I would suggest that you should explain to them that the Society's fees are payable in cash upon the completion of the classification surveys, and suggest to them that they should make arrangements for the fees due on the "LEOPOLDVILLE" to be paid in cash now, in accordance with the Society's usual practice.
