S/S "LEOPOLDVILLE" No. 623 yard number on the 7th September 1928
whilst the vessel was at the yard during construction and on
the 22nd July 1929 whilst the vessel was in the No. 7 city dry
dock at Antwerp for the purpose of ascertaining the nature
& extent of the damage stated to have been caused by:-

- 1) Propeller shaft marked F.L.R. 746 having dropped owing to
sling breaking when lifting the shaft on to the vessel.
- 2nd) Starboard propeller striking mooring chain whilst trying
engines at the yard at Hoboken.

Upon making examination.

FOUND

RECOMMENDED

1st Damage.

Propeller shaft liner badly cut Liner to be removed, shaft to be
and grooved in way of neck bush, examined in the lathe and a new
liner to be fitted.

2nd Damage.

The 3 bronze blades of the
starboard propeller slightly
bent & fractured at the tips.

The tips of the 3 propeller
blades to be dressed up.
