particulars of Casualty This vessel arrived in port after being badly damaged by enemy action about 13th December, 1942. She was badly fractured amidships and was sagging and it is stated that temporary repairs were considered impossible and that permanent repairs would necessitate cutting her in two and rejoining.

British Registration closed.

It has been agreed that the vessel is a constructive total loss and it is proposed to salve machinery later and strip her.
