Messrs. The Burntisland S.B. Co.'s Yard No. 218.

Herewith we enclose "sketch showing derrick post and ventilator" for the above vessel.

As the post at forward end of bridge deck is being worked the builders do not wish at this time to change the present arrangement, therefore in lieu of fitting a heavier plate above Bridge Deck (as per Section 26, paragraph 2 (a) and (b) of the Rules) it is proposed to extend the deck doubling to 18" above the deck, or in lieu to fit three internal angles from the deck to the height of goose neck.

The derrick post ventilator at after end of bridge is of similar construction, but as the opening is on the casing top it is concluded that the present arrangement is in order, subject to efficient stays being fitted. We shall be glad to be informed if the above proposed arrangements are in order.

For your information we enclose a copy of plan of "Arrangement of Masts for electric welding" these masts are of similar construction to the derrick posts except a slight difference/


