I return herewith the above plans submitted with your letters of the 12th and 23rd instant and with regard thereto I have to inform you that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended thereon be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with and the materials and workmanship be to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100 A.1.

At the same time I have to draw your attention to the Committee's recommendations as set forth in the Rules for the additional strengthening of the bottom if it is desired to load or discharge cargo while the vessel is lying aground.
