This vessel was built by Messrs William Doxford & Sons in 1910 and classed with the British Corporation.

Plans and particulars of the scantlings forwarded in the case of the sister vessel "Istina" were examined in this Office and the Trieste Surveyors were informed that provided the requirements of the rules for ships not built under survey be complied with and a favourable report be received, the vessel could be favourably recommended for 100 A.1 class.

The Trieste Surveyors now forward a report giving particulars of the scantlings for this vessel and report the vessel examined in dry dock, the requirements of a No.3 survey carried out, repairs effected to double bottom tank under engines, tank side brackets in holds, bunkers, deck in way of donkey boiler, 4 bridge deck plates renewed in way of accomodation were covered with litosilo and minor repairs carried out.

The materials and workmanship are good.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100 A.1 with record of survey 6-25 and notation of s.s. Tri. No.3-6-25.

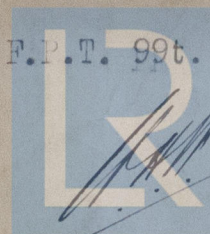
