Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter (unsigned) of the 22nd instant, together with a First Entry Report on the Steel S.S. "ROYAL STAR" ex "WAR CHARON" and with regard thereto I have to request that Mr. McIlvenna will be so good as to state whether he is correct in reporting that the rivets in the butts of "A", "B", "C" and "D" strakes are spaced 4" apart from centre to centre.

At the same time I have to state that as the classification of this Standard "G" Type vessel in the Register Book is 100 A1 "Shelter Deck" with Freeboard, you should forward the usual freeboard report.

It is presumed that the freeboards for this vessel were assigned by the British Corporation and if so, you should furnish particulars of these freeboards and state whether you verified the marking.
