I beg to acquaint you that the Load Line Certificate of the steamer "SILVERLAUREL" will expire on the 31st January next and I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what arrangements you propose making to carry out the requisite renewal survey.

I have to add that the greater part of the Special Survey No. 1 of the hull has been carried out and to complete the same, the bottom, rudder, and windlass require to be examined and the fore peak tank and D.B. tanks (except in way of deep tanks) require to be tested. The validity in respect of the present notation of "Examined" expires at the end of February next and unless it is anticipated that circumstances will permit the completion of the Special Survey it is concluded that the vessel will be submitted to the inspection of the Society's Surveyors, concurrently with the Load Line Survey, with a view to the assignment of a further notation of "Examined" with date in the Register Book.

I take this opportunity to inform you that the water tube Boiler Survey also becomes due at the end of February next.
