I return herewith one set of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 15th instant, showing arrangement of closed feed system proposed for The Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co's Contract No.932 (Messrs. J.L.Thompson & Sons' Yard No.588), and have to acquaint you that these plans will be approved, provided the steel castings be made at approved works and tested as required by the Rules and the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

It is noted that there is no feed water filter on the main feed lines, and it is concluded that the exhaust steam from the auxiliary reciprocating feed pumps is led only to the auxiliary condenser and that there are no auxiliaries driven by reciprocating steam engines which exhaust to the main condenser. I shall, however, be glad to receive confirmation on these points.
