Dear Sirs,

E. I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 25th instant, of amended arrangement of forward hold bilge suction proposed for Messrs. J.L. Thompson & Sons' Yard No. 588, and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved, as shown and amended, provided the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1937-8) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that the wing suction and filling connection to No. 3 double bottom tank is stated to be 4" bore instead of 3" as indicated on the previously approved plans. In the circumstances, if it is intended to retain this connection at 4", it will be necessary for the size of the air pipes to this tank to be increased to suit.
