I return herewith the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 8th instant, showing Arrangement of Main Steam Pipes proposed for the above contract, and have to inform you that these plans will be approved provided the thickness of pipes Nos.1063 to 1069 be not less than 10 L.S.G., the arrangement of drains be to your satisfaction, the steel castings be made at approved works and tested as required by the Rules, and the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

It is concluded that the pressures in pipes Nos.1028 and 1047-9 will not exceed 91 lb. per sq. inch and 93 lb. per sq. inch respectively, and that the superheater safety valves will be set to blow at 400 lb. per sq. inch, but I shall be glad to receive confirmation on these points.

I shall also be glad if you will furnish me with verified copies of the plans for record purposes.
