
E. I duly received your letter of the 8th instant, with enclosures, respecting the Feed Heaters proposed by Messrs. G. & J. Weir Ltd., for The Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co's Contract No.932 - Messrs. J.L. Thompson's Yard No.588, and have to acquaint you that the following plans of H.P. and L.P. Feed Water Heaters will be approved for the designed working pressures stated below, provided the steel castings be made at an approved works and tested as required by the Rules, the welding be to the Surveyors' satisfaction and the heaters be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, viz:-
