December, 1938 and subsequently, for the purpose of inspecting and witnessing the hydraulic test on Two Mild Steel Riveted Air Receivers, 6'6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " overall length x 1'7" inside diameter made to the order of The National Gas & Oil Engine Co., Ltd., Order No. 53911/REP., and intended for the vessel "SILVER LAUREL".

The plates from which the receivers were made were identified from signed mill Sheets, the receivers were examined during construction, the workmanship throughout being satisfactory.

When completed the receivers were tested by hydraulic pressure to 465 lb. per square inch, examined under this pressure and, as far as could be seen, were satisfactory, showing no signs of leakage.

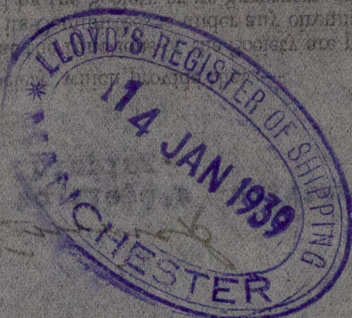
