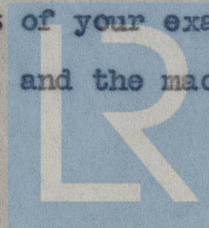

With reference to your letter of the 17th instant respecting a proposal to install in the above vessel electrically driven refrigerating machinery taken out of the M.V. "DEVON CITY", I have to inform you that Messrs. Harte, Lindley & Co., the Consulting Engineers to the Owners in this City, have already been in communication with this Office on the subject, and I send herewith, for your information, a copy of a letter, dated the 9th instant, addressed to them in the matter.

In reply to your enquiry I have to say that it will be necessary for you to witness the hydraulic tests, as required by the Rules, on all parts subjected to CO₂. Tests other than hydraulic tests will not be required in the present instance provided you be satisfied with the result of your examination of the machinery when opened up, and the machinery be found entirely
